OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE CAMP WITH KELLY KLEIN – AGES 6-9

9am to 4pm, Mon to Fri, July 23rd-27th, 2018 ~ Open to boys and girls ages six to nine.

Registration \$150.00 (all supplies included). *Students bring lunch, supervised break provided.*

Outdoor adventure and survival activities including:

- Archery for beginners including identifying parts of a bow, proper handling and stance, safety and target shooting with Archers & Bowhunters Association of Manitoba
- Orienteering, using a compass, reading a map, using the sun and stars as a guide
- Basics in camping including choosing a campsite, tent set-up, building a fire, starting a fire without matches, outdoor cooking, making a grill and campfire tripod
- Build an emergency shelter and learn how to use a first aid kit
- Make outdoor furniture and utensils
- String a fishing rod and make lures
- Learn how to use rope and tie knots
- Back-country hiking in the park and around the community
- Baseball if time permits
- The TCI gymnasium will be available for basketball and badminton if there is a need to spend some time indoors.

Outdoor adventure, camping and survival activities with two overnights at Norris Lake including:

~**Mon and Tues 9am to 4pm at GAAC** – Camping basics in preparation for overnight at Norris Lake including choosing a campsite, tent set-up, building and starting a fire without matches, outdoor cooking, making a grill, campfire tripod, learn how to use rope and tie knots, food and gear prep and pack-up. Tuesday will also include archery for beginners including identifying parts of a bow, proper handling and stance, safety and target shooting with Archers & Bowhunters Association of Manitoba

~**Wed 9am camping trip at Norris Lake begins!** – Parent drop off at Norris Lake or rides can be arranged from GAAC. Overnight Wed and Thurs in tents at designated group campground. Pick up at GAAC Friday at noon. Parent permission required for rides and camp activities including how to safely use and sharpen an axe and knife, fishing (with instruction on how to string a fishing rod and make lures), swimming, outdoor cooking.
